Atlanta Notes

- Atlanta's record against Connecticut moves to 28-23 all-time.
- The Dream started Odyssey Sims, Chennedy Carter, Courtney Williams, Tianna Hawkins and Elizabeth Williams.
- Four Dream players scored in double digits as Sims and Courtney Williams both finished with 14 points, Hawkins finished with 11 and Carter scored 10.
- Monique Billings blocked a career-high four shots Friday night (previous: 3, twice).
- Crystal Bradford tied her career high record with five defensive and five total rebounds (last: 8/26/15).
- Elizabeth Williams' putback layup in beginning of the first quarter marked the first Dream points in Gateway Center Arena @ College Park.
- Rookie Aari McDonald made her WNBA debut Friday night, finishing with two rebounds and two steals.
